In [Truck Features](#) we added more historic info to our very popular History of Road Trains story.

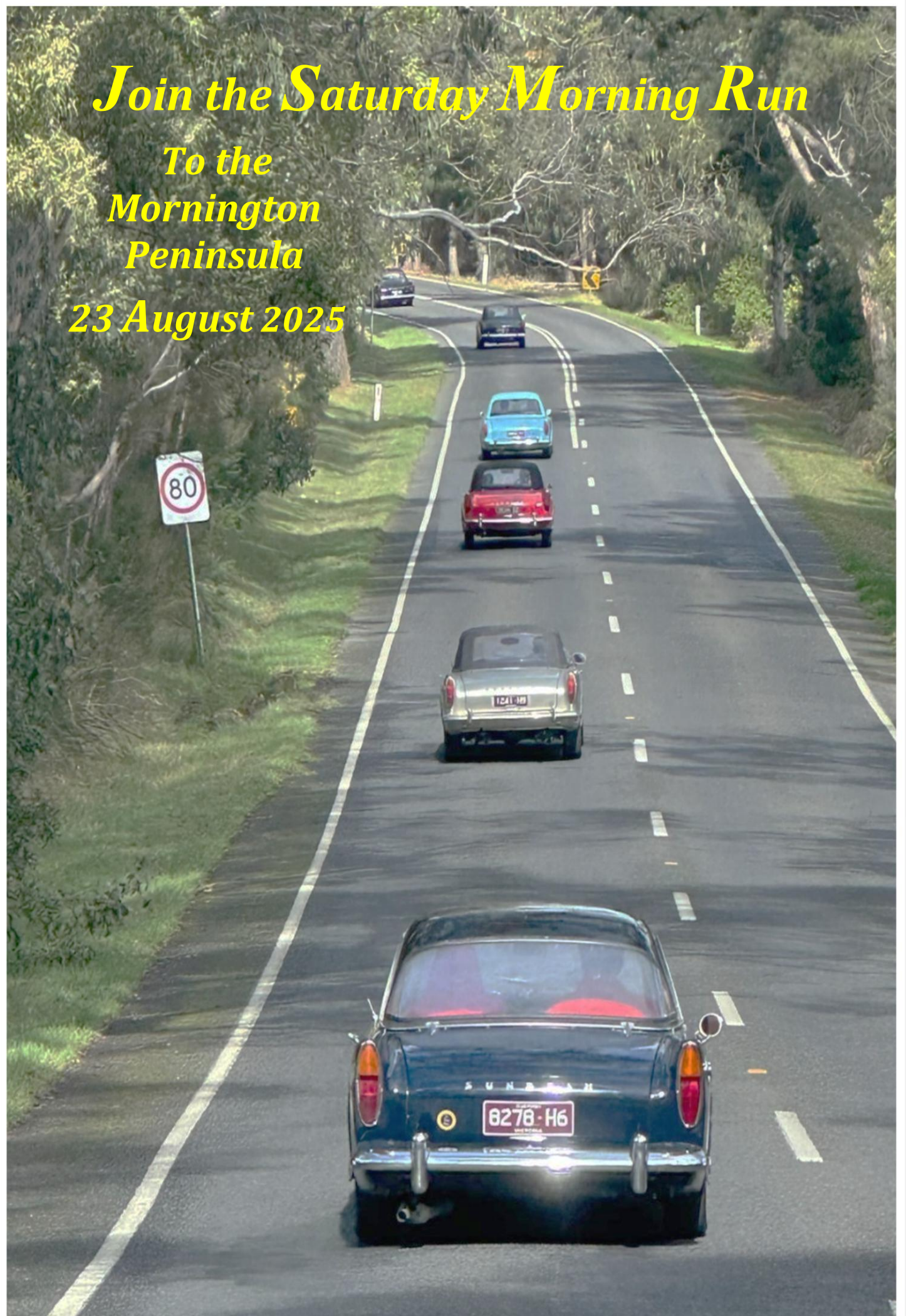

If you have not received a renewal form at least 2 weeks prior to the date the permit expires, contact VicRoads and request the required CPS renewal form, including a new logbook.

- 2. CONTACT the Club Permit Officer** to sign the Club Permit Renewal Form.

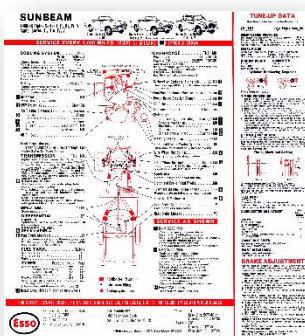

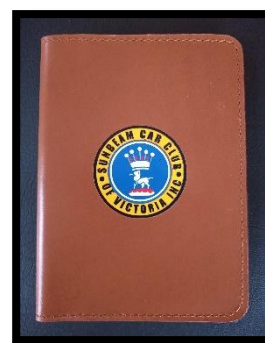
